

Curt Lunchick is Head of Nondietary Exposure and Risk Assessment for Bayer CropSciences (1998 to present). In that capacity, he is responsible for the conduct of nondietary occupational and residential exposure and risk assessments. He is also currently involved in the development of an industry exposure database to replace the Pesticide Handlers Exposure Database. Prior to Bayer CropScience and its predecessors Aventis and Rhone-Poulenc, he was a consultant at Jellinek, Schwartz, & Connolly conducting nondietary exposure assessments (1992 -1998) and he also worked in EPA's Office of Pesticide Programs from 1984 to 1992. During that time he worked on the Worker Protection Standard, the Pesticide Handlers Exposure Database development, the Subdivision U Applicator Exposure Study guidelines, and Agency reviews of pesticides such as Alachlor, Parathion, Dinoseb, and Atrazine. He graduated from the University of Maryland with a BS in Animal Science (1974) and North Carolina State University with a MS in Animal Nutrition.
